1 Introduction

Welcome to Mzuzi Postcode Address (MPA), the easy-to-use postcode system that helps you to use the Mzuzi Postcode Address System. This guide will help you get started with the Mzuzi Postcode Address system and provide you with all the information you need to make the most of its features.

This User Manual (UM) provides the information necessary for all the users to effectively use the Mzuzi Postcode Address System (MPAS).

1.1 Overview

The Mzuzi Postcode Address system is a postcode system designed to help people in the 7 East African Community (EAC) countries, to register their business or property for a unique address identifier. The system assigns a unique postcode to each property, business, organisation, and government entities in the Mzuzi EAC region, allowing for faster and more efficient delivery of goods and services. The purpose of the Mzuzi Postcode system is to streamline the process of identifying and organizing postcode addresses, making it easier for businesses, individuals, organisations, and governments to deliver, and provide services efficiently.

2 Getting Started

To use Mzuzi Postcode Address, you will need to do this by visiting the Mzuzi website(<https://www.mzuzigroup.com>) and follow the user instructions provided in this user manual. You can also register your business or property for an address using the Business Registration form provided on the website. Either way, these allow you fully access, and use the Mzuzi Postcode Address system.

3 Using Mzuzi Postcode

3.1 Caution and Warnings

1. The system only works when connected to internet.
2. Only registered postcode addresses can be searched.

3. The system is configured to display a maximum list of 30 postcode address options per search.

4. At the moment, users can only search for addresses in EAC region using the Mzuzi Postcode Website and the Mzuzi Postcode App.

To use Mzuzi Postcode, simply go to.

- 1 The Mzuzi website (<https://www.mzuzigroup.com>)
- 2 On the website go to the main home page, products (click open Mzuzi Address, or find address (select country)
- 3 Then search for any postcode address using any of the above pages in 2 above.
- 4 Then Find a Registered Address.
- 5 Then use **SEARCH BOX** to search for any address following the steps below.

3.2 Step One

Start by typing a postcode or any part of an address and results will start appearing. For example, when you type in,

1. 10101 in the search box, addresses in Kampala civic centre, will start showing.
2. Kampala addresses with a Kampala element in them will show.
3. Nairobi for Mzuzi registered addresses in Nairobi City Kenya.
4. Kigali for registered addresses in Kigali City Rwanda
5. Bujumbura for registered addresses in Bujumbura City Burundi
6. Dar es Salaam for addresses in Dar es Sallam City in Tanzania.
7. Kinshasa for registered addresses in Kinshasa City in the DRC.
8. Juba for registered addresses in Juba City South Sudan.

9. You can type in the name of the address/business/building for instance, International Hospital Kampala (Uganda), Sonko Mjinga (Burundi), Vision Pharma (DRC), Hilton Nairobi (Kenya), The Governors Residence (Rwanda), African Bureau (South Sudan), or Dodoma Municipal Council (Tanzania). This gives you those address, and any other addresses associated with them.
10. Or the name of the city or district, registered addresses in that city/district will appear, you can then select the desired address, to view the address location.

3.3 Step 2

The more information you provide, the more you will narrow your search. See below.

1. 10101 will list addresses in Kampala civic centre, 10108 will list addresses in Nakasero 11, and Kololo will list the addresses in Kololo.
2. K10D will list that address in Kinshasa.
3. K5R 2KG will give you that address in Kigali.
4. B4B will list addresses in Bujumbura CBD2.
5. 20214 will list addresses in Nairobi Kenya.
6. 144 14 will give you that address in Dar es Salaam.
7. J6S will list address in Juba South Sudan.

You can then scroll through the results to select the address you need. The steps in 2, apply to any of the **Districts/Cities** in each of the 7 countries.

3.4 Step 3

Type in the starting initial or the first two initials of any of the districts in any of the countries. For Instance,

OR just type the city or district name i.e., Hoima, Lira, Kisoro, Rakai, Iganga, Nakapilipilit-Uganda, or Awerial-South Sudan, Bugoma South- Kenya, Nyamagabe-Rwanda, Bagamoyo-Tanzania, Buganda-Burundi, and or Bas-Fleuve district-DRC.

You can then scroll through the address list options to select the address you need. The steps above apply to all the cities and districts in each of the 7 countries of EAC. **NOTE: Only registered address can be searched.**

3.5 Step 4

The quickest way is to type in the full postcode if you know it. In this case,

4 Search for Business Addresses

Users can also search for business addresses in the same way. If the company or business name is known to you (for example, 'Mzuzi Group Limited' , 'Sonko Mjingo' (Burundi), 'Vision Pharma' (DRC), 'Village Market' (Kenya), 'Five Volcanoes' (Rwanda), 'African Bureau' (South Sudan), or High Court of Justice'(Tanzania). ...etc.). Just type in the entity's name and scroll through the address options listed to select the postcode/address of interest. This will give you addresses or whatever business/company name of interest you are searching for.

5 Search for a Building Name

Some properties or business use '**ALIAS**' names. However, every property still has a thoroughfare address, even if it is not commonly used. You can use the building name (for example, 'Crested Towers' to search for an address. This will give the address of the building and all the addresses associated with that particular building, commonly called a **Delivery Point**. Also, when you type in the Search Box 'Crested Towers, or Hannington Road ', and or '10108 K3HR ' you will get the same result.

6 How to view address location or locations

1. Once you select the needed address, the location of address should show on the map of the area.
2. When you enter the postcode and hit enter or search, the location should show on the map of the location.
3. The address location is indicated by the 'Red Marker' with a Mzuzi logo pointing to the location.
4. You can zoom in/out using the ('+ or – signs') for better results of the location or address of interest.
5. The address location can be viewed both using the 'Google maps', and 'Google satellite' view. Whatever the user desires.
6. Note though that only address locations already covered by 'Google Street view' can be viewed through 'street view'. Those not yet mapped on Google Street view can only be viewed in the Map, Satellite or Terrain modes.
7. You can have a feel-good view by zooming in/out for a total tour of the address location surroundings.
8. On the Mzuzi Postcode App, users can select the **Start Navigation** for route directions to the address location.

Mzuzi Postcode offers a range of parameters to help you search, view, and manage your address. These include the ability to search for addresses by postcode, entity name, business name, thoroughfare, area location name, district, and the city name.
